4.	Definitions	Fire Prevention Officer – a person who is appointed by the Fire Marshal to carry out limited authority of the Fire Prevention Act and its regulations throughout the province.		
5.	Policy Guidelines	In order to ensure the legal authority and liability protection to conduct fire safety inspections and relevant fire prevention efforts, every person holding the title of Fire Prevention Officer in Province of NB should be appointed by the Fire Marshal as a Local Assistant under the FPA.		
6.	Procedures Process Maps / Guidelines/ Forms	Upon designating an individual to hold the position of Fire Prevention Officer, the local authority is responsible to inform the Fire Marshal of such a designation and forward appropriate documentation for appointment under the <i>FPA</i> directly to the Office of the Fire Marshal. Such documentation will include but is not limited to: 1) Application for appointment; 2) Completed Vulnerable Sector Check; 3) Signed form authorizing the OFM to use the appointees picture on file with Service New Brunswick from his/her Motor Vehicle license. 4) Proof of any relevant training (certificates, etc.) All forms required for the above noted appointment(s) are available on the OFM website or by contacting the Office of the Fire Marshal. Persons holding the appointment of Fire Prevention Officer will receive an appropriate designation as a statement of willingness to carry out the authority of ss. 11, 12, 13(3), 16, 19(3) and 21(1) and 23
