SUBJECT: 1. GNB COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

ITEM 1 section 00 22 13 - SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

.1 The following paragraphs have been added to the front end specification section 00 22 13 - SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

1.4 GNB COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTORS, SUB-CONTRACTORS, VENDORS, SUPPLIERS

- .1 Contractors, sub-contractors, vendors and suppliers must comply with all GNB health and safety policies and standards including, without limitation, all health and safety policies and standards related to COVID-19, as applicable. Go to www.gnb.ca/nbon to view the full policy and FAQs.
- .2 Proof of vaccination (or medical exemption) is required for anyone working onsite in GNB workplaces, whether during regular business hours or not. However, this requirement does not extend to delivery workers.
- .3 Proof of vaccination shall be in the form of written confirmation on the General Contractor's company letterhead stating that:
 - .1 All General Contractor's staff, sub-contractors, vendors and suppliers who will be on-site in GNB workplaces are fully vaccinated per the "GNB COVID-19 Vaccination Policy Requirement for Contractors, Sub-Contractors, Vendors and Suppliers"
 - .2 General Contractor will manage and comply with the policy for the duration of the contract.

ITEM 2 section 00 43 00 - SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

- .1 Article named "COVID-19 CONSTRUCTION SAFETY PLAN" is now called "COVID-19 CONSTRUCTION SAFETY PLAN & PROOF OF VACCINATION"
- .2 Add Item 1.5.2 under "COVID-19 CONSTRUCTION SAFETY PLAN & PROOF OF VACCINATION" as follows:

- .2 Provide written confirmation on the General Contractor's company letterhead stating that:
 - .1 All General Contractor's staff, sub-contractors, vendors and suppliers who will be on-site in GNB workplaces are fully vaccinated per the "GNB COVID-19 Vaccination Policy Requirements for Contractors, Sub-Contractors, Vendors and Suppliers"
 - .2 General Contractor will manage and comply with the policy for the duration of the contract.
