Questions to consider for potential victims of Human Trafficking

- Does the person have freedom of movement?
- Has the person been physically/sexually abused?
- Has the person or their loved ones been threatened?
- Was identification or documentation taken from the person?
- Has the person been paid for his/her work or services? How much?
- How many hours does the person work a day?
- What are the living conditions?
- Has the person paid any money in advance to come to the area?
- How did the person find out about the job?
- Are there other victims?

Physical Abuse Questions:

- Were you ever threatened?
- Did you ever witness any threats against other people?
- Have your family or loved ones been threatened?
- Were you ever physically abused, or did you ever witness abuse against another person?
- Were you allowed to access medical care?

Freedom of movement questions:

- Was your freedom of movement restricted?
- · Did you live and work in the same place?
- What were the conditions under which you were left unattended?
- Did you have access to your family and friends, food, telephone, television, the Internet, and transportation?

Fraud/Financial Questions:

- How did you come to Canada or this area?
- Were you provided false documents or identification?
- Are you in possession of your own legal documents? If not, why?
- How did you pay for your trip to Canada or this area?
- Do you owe money to anyone?
- Did you come to Canada or this area for a specific job/study program that you were promised?
- How did you find your job?
- Was there some sort of work contract signed? Were you given a copy?
- Were you forced to do work other than what was promised?
- Are you getting paid for the work that you do? How much?
- What is your legal status in Canada?
