on palliative care and end-of-life care

The New Brunswick Cancer Network's Oncology Education Day will focus on palliative care using a regional education model. This Education Day is designed to enhance knowledge in cancer care to meet the educational needs of interdisciplinary health professionals.

The Education Day will follow the *Education in Palliative & End-of-Life Care – Oncology in Canada (EPECTM-O Canada)* program.

Topics included are:
models of comprehensive care; loss grief and bereavement;
spiritual needs; cancer pain management; and
advanced care planning.

As a result of this Education Day, participants will have enhanced palliative care knowledge and access to a trainer's tool kit to organize or deliver programs within their respective areas. Participants will also receive access to an online community of practice.
