SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The agricultural equipment technician occupation includes

- (a) the interpreting of parts and service manuals;
- (b) the using of hand tools and shop equipment;
- (c) the repairing, maintaining and servicing of gasoline and diesel engines, fuel systems, electronic and electrical systems, intake and exhaust systems, engine lubrication systems, liquid and air cooling systems and related assemblies;
- (d) the repairing, maintaining and servicing of brakes, steering, suspension, wheels, tires, tubes and related assemblies;
- (e) the repairing, maintaining and servicing of clutches, torque converters, transmissions, axles, differentials, drive lines and related assemblies;
- (f) the repairing, maintaining and servicing of agricultural machinery and implements;
- (g) the repairing, maintaining and servicing of hydraulic, mechanical and air machine systems and related assemblies;
- (h) the using of arc and gas welding equipment; and
- (i) the identifying of hazards and the performing of skills or functions related to the agricultural equipment technician occupation in a safe manner.
