SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The concrete finisher occupation includes

- (a) the preparing of the site;
- (b) the handling of concrete;
- (c) the consolidating and compacting of concrete;
- (d) the edging, jointing and grooving of concrete;
- (e) the producing of various finishes on concrete surfaces;
- (f) the applying of treatments to concrete;
- (g) the cutting and coring of hardened concrete;
- (h) the scarifying of concrete;
- (i) the applying of dry, wet and epoxy grouts;
- (j) the interpreting of detailed drawings, blueprints and other specifications;
- (k) the using of power consolidating, power screening and power trowelling equipment;
- (l) the setting up and assembling of rigging and hoisting equipment;
- (m) the dry packing, grouting and finishing when setting machinery; and
- (n) the correcting, repairing and modifying of concrete.
