## SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The distribution construction lineman occupation includes

- (a) the constructing and maintaining of power lines and related equipment both overhead and underground;
- (b) the demonstrating of a working knowledge of communication line installation practices;
- (c) the maintaining of a working knowledge of working clearances, construction standards and safety regulations;
- (d) the operating and maintaining of tools and equipment associated with the distribution construction lineman occupation;
- (e) the performing of good customer relations;
- (f) the performing of routine switching operations on distribution transformers; and
- (g) the performing of other switching operations under the direct supervision of qualified personnel.
