## SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The hairstylist occupation includes

- (a) the preparing of clients for services;
- (b) the sanitizing and disinfecting of tools, equipment and accessories;
- (c) the shampooing, conditioning and treating of hair and scalp;
- (d) the cutting and trimming of hair using shears, razors and clippers;
- (e) the styling of wet and dry hair using products and tools to obtain the desired look;
- (f) the chemical waving or relaxing of hair using products and tools;
- (g) the selecting, mixing and applying of colouring and bleaching products;
- (h) the selecting, fitting, and styling of wigs and hairpieces;
- (i) the adding, maintaining and removing of hair extensions; and
- (j) the performing of sales and marketing to clients.
