SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

In this section, "heavy equipment compaction roller" means compaction equipment used to compact earth, rock, gravel or other materials.

The heavy equipment operator compaction roller occupation includes:

(a) the performing of routine inspection and service procedures;

(b) the carrying out of checks before the operation of the compaction roller and continual visual checks during operation;

- (c) the operating of the compaction roller to compact materials during construction and related activities;
- (d) the maintaining of records; and
- (e) the interpreting of information on grade stakes and drawings.
