SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

In this section, "heavy equipment dozer" means earth-moving equipment used to move, spread and strip earth, rock, gravel or other materials during construction and related activities.

The heavy equipment operator dozer occupation includes:

- (a) the performing of routine inspection and service procedures;
- (b) the carrying out of checks before the operation of the dozer and continual visual checks during operation;
- (c) the operating of the dozer to move, and grade materials during construction and related activities;
- (e) the maintaining of records; and
- (f) the interpreting of information on grade stakes and drawings.
