SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

In this section, "heavy equipment excavator" means earth-moving equipment used to excavate, move, lift, strip, stockpile, grade and place, earth, rock, gravel or other materials.

The heavy equipment operator excavator occupation includes:

- (a) the performing of routine inspection and service procedures;
- (b) the carrying out of checks before the operation of the excavator and continual visual checks during operation;
- (c) the operating of the excavator to move, load, unload and grade materials during construction and related activities;
- (d) the maintaining of records; and
- (e) the interpreting of information on grade stakes and drawings.
