## SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

In this section, "heavy equipment loader" means earth-moving equipment used to move, strip, stock pile, load, grade and unload earth, rock, gravel or other materials.

The heavy equipment operator loader occupation includes:

- (a) the performing of routine inspection and service procedures;
- (b) the carrying out of checks before the operation of the loader and continual visual checks during operation;
- (c) the operating of the loader to move materials during construction and related activities;
- (d) the maintaining of records; and
- (e) the interpreting of information on grade stakes and drawings.
