## SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

In this section, "heavy equipment tractor loader backhoe" means earth-moving equipment used to move and load earth, rock, gravel or other materials during construction and related activities, including clean-up operations.

The Heavy Equipment Operator Tractor Loader Backhoe occupation includes:

(a) the performing of routine inspection and service procedures;

(b) the carrying out of checks before the operation of the Tractor Loader Backhoe and continual visual checks during operation;

(c) the operating of the Tractor Loader Backhoe to move, load, unload and grade materials during construction and related activities;

(d) the maintaining of records; and

(e) the interpreting of information on grade stakes and drawings.
