SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The insulator (heat and frost) occupation includes

(a) the handling, fabricating and applying of insulation products for thermal control;

(b) the spraying, pouring and mixing of insulation products;

(c) the repairing, reconditioning, adjusting and maintaining of insulation systems;

(d) the erecting, assembling, moulding, altering and dismantling of components used in the insulator occupation;

(e) the installing of finish materials to insulation including all service jackets, metal, plastic, cement, mastic and reinforcing mesh;

(f) the applying of weatherproofing materials for hot or cold thermal insulation;

(g) the abatement and removal of asbestos relating to the insulator occupation;

(h) the installing of thermal insulation on pipes, fittings and valves in hot and cold applications;

(i) the installing of insulation and related finishing materials on boilers, ducts, flues, tanks, vats and equipment;

(j) the applying of insulation for fire proofing, fire stopping and sound proofing; and

(k) the using of hand and power tools and equipment related to the insulator occupation including pin and stud welding equipment.
