- the erecting and dismantling of pre-cast and prestressed concrete; (b)
- the installing of conveyors and other material handling systems; (c)
- the installing of curtain walls and ornamental ironwork; (d)
- (e) the rigging of machinery and heavy equipment;
- the tacking, burning and edge preparation of ferrous and non-ferrous metals; (f)
- (g) the selecting, erecting and dismantling of scaffolding; and
- (h) the interpreting of blueprints and symbols.
