SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The landscape-horticulturist occupation includes

- (a) the installing and maintaining of landscape features, such as lawns, gardens, patios, driveways, retaining walls, stairways, water features and irrigation systems;
- (b) the installing, maintaining and pruning of trees, shrubs and other plants;
- (c) the fertilizing of lawns and gardens;
- (d) the identifying of plants;
- (e) the aerating and dethatching of turf;
- (f) the maintaining of pest control;
- (g) the operating, maintaining and safe use of all landscaping equipment;
- (h) the using of grading and drainage instruments; and
- (i) the interpreting of plans and drawings.
