

### SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The painter and decorator occupation includes

- (a) the applying of coats of paint, varnish, shellac and similar materials to exterior and interior surfaces, trimmings and fixtures of buildings to protect and decorate them;
- (b) the preparing of surfaces for repainting or decorating by the removing of old paint with a scraper, wire brush, liquid paint remover or heat gun, the cleaning of surfaces with a brush, cloth, abrasive materials or abrasive and water blasting and the patching of cracks and holes with putty, plastic wood or other filler;
- (c) the erecting of scaffolding, ladders or other equipment to safety standards for working at higher levels;
- (d) the mixing of paint according to colour and other characteristics required by stirring together proportions of pigment, oil, thinner and drying substances;
- (e) the applying of paint and other materials to surfaces with a brush, roller, spray-gun, sponge or rag;
- (f) the removing of old wall coverings with a scraper, water and chemicals or steamers, the cleaning of surfaces, the filling of cracks and holes with plaster and the brushing of sizing on surfaces;
- (g) the measuring of surfaces to be covered and the cutting of rolls of wall coverings to required length;
- (h) the mixing of paste and the preparing and placing of strips of wall coverings on ceilings or walls;
- (i) the matching of adjacent edges, ends and corners on wall coverings;
- (j) the trimming of ends of wall coverings to proper length;
- (k) the skillful and safe using of all tools and equipment required in the painter and decorator occupation, including drywall finishing and veneer plastering; and
- (l) the installing of fabrics and other materials.
