SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The roofer occupation includes

the applying of built-up roofs, the laying of vapour barriers and insulation, the securing, mopping, stripping (a) and gravelling of roofs, including the fabricating and installing of all sheet metal roof related flashings;

- (b) the applying of asphalt saturated shingles;
- the applying of modified bitumen roofing systems; (c)

the applying of single ply roofing systems including EPDM (ethylene propylene diene monomer) and PVC (d) (polyvinyl chloride) membranes;

- the installing of tapered roof insulation systems in accordance with the manufacturer's layout drawings; (e)
- (f) the applying of membrane waterproofing to foundation walls, floor slabs and bridge decks;

the inspecting of problem roofs and determining the extent and procedure of repairing or removing and (g) replacing;

- (h) the installing of all roof drain inserts and drain clamps;
- (i) the installing of roof accessories, roof vent flashings and anchor bolt flashings;
- the interpreting of blueprints and specifications; and (j)
- the working in coordination with allied occupations engaged in construction. (k)
