## SCOPE OF THE OCCUPATION

The tilesetter occupation includes

- (a) the covering, repairing and decorating of exterior and interior walls, ceilings, floors and other surfaces using ceramic, mosaic, marble and quarry tile, slate, stone or granite slabs and terrazzo;
- (b) the reading and interpreting of architectural drawings and materials specifications to determine layout, finish and installation;
- (c) the selecting, mixing, applying and spreading of mortars, grouts, mastics and other adhesives for the preparation and installation of materials;
- (d) the reinforcing or building of an underbase as required to support the finish material;
- (e) the finishing of material by grouting, surfacing and polishing by hand or machine; and
- (f) the installing of pre-cast terrazzo, granite or marble units.
