- (e) the fitting and finishing of metal stock and castings;
- (f) the performing of bench work operations;
- (g) the operating of power sawing equipment;
- (h) the performing of milling operations;
- (i) the performing of lathe operations;
- (j) the performing of drilling operations;
- (k) the performing of grinding operations; and
- (1) the interpreting of drawings.
