The truck and transport mechanic occupation includes

- (a) the interpreting and using of service manuals and work reports;
- (b) the repairing, maintaining and servicing of gasoline and diesel engines, clutches, torque converters, transmissions, axles, differentials, drive lines, brakes, steering, suspensions, wheels, tires, tubes and related assemblies;
- (c) the maintaining and servicing of fuel, electrical, hydraulic, air, cooling, lubricating, intake and exhaust systems on all types of heavy duty highway trucks, tractors and buses; and
- (d) the repairing, maintaining and servicing of highway truck-and-tractor trailers.
