To maintain Age-Friendly Community Recognition status, municipalities/communities must demonstrate this ongoing commitment to their age-friendly initiative and action plan **every three years**.

To apply to maintain your Age-Friendly Community Recognition status, complete and submit the signed form to seniors@gnb.ca with the required documents.

Please submit the following required documents in PDF format.

- Terms of Reference for the Age-Friendly Advisory Committee
- Evidence that the Age-Friendly Advisory Committee met a minimum of four times annually to monitor the implementation of the current Age-Friendly Community Action Plan
- Evidence of continued community engagement with seniors and other relevant stakeholders
- A one-page status report showing progress of your current Age-Friendly Community Action Plan
- Updated Age-Friendly Community Action Plan for the next 3 years
