## Almost half of New Brunswickers have college or university education

<u>Educational attainment</u> refers to the highest level of education that a person has successfully completed. The <u>highest</u> certificate, diploma or degree is the classification used in the census to measure this concept.

- In 2016, nearly half (48.2%) of New Brunswick's adult population aged 25 to 64 had either college or university qualifications. 26.1% of New Brunswickers had a college certificate or diploma, 1.9% had a university certificate below bachelor's degree and 20.2% had a bachelor's degree or higher.
- In addition, 9.4% of the adult population had an apprenticeship or other trades certificate, while 28.5% had a high school diploma. The remaining 13.9% of New Brunswickers had no certificate, diploma or degree.
- Nationally, 54.0% of Canadians aged 25 to 64 had either college or university qualifications. 22.4% had a college diploma, 3.1% had a university certificate below bachelor's degree and 28.5% had a bachelor's degree or higher. A further 10.8% had an apprenticeship or other trades certificate, 23.7% had a high school diploma and 11.5% had no certificate, diploma or degree.
